






Christmas is already looking very busy for the team at the Hub and around the village. This edition of the newsletter has lots of updates of festive offerings from various groups in the village.

We are delighted to share that work to upgrade the bowlers' path behind Cuthill Crescent, which leads to Addiewell has been completed. A huge thanks to McLaren Plant Ltd for the swift completion of the project and to residents for their support too. This important improvement will also link to the existing Fulshie route, creating a circular walking network, although a crossing over the main road will still be required.

Our service offers a safe, welcoming space where people can come together and share with peers. We take a trauma-informed approach, making sure support is respectful, understanding, and inclusive.




